Navin Haffty Successfully Implements MEDITECH Expanse for Canada's Largest Pediatric Rehabilitation Hospital



Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital in Toronto is the largest children's rehabilitation hospital in Canada and is a leading teaching hospital fully affiliated with the University of Toronto.

Project Challenges

A long-time user of the MEDITECH Client/Server (C/S) 5.66 platform, Holland Bloorview contracted with MEDITECH to implement the Expanse platform in the acute and ambulatory settings, selecting Expanse due to its state-of-the-art web functionalities. Through the migration to MEDITECH's fully interoperable web-based EHR platform, Holland Bloorview's strategic vision was set on delivering significant improvements to the quality and efficiency of patient care, as well as achieving Electronic Medical Record Adoption Model (EMRAM) Stage 7. With this implementation, Holland Bloorview would be the first Canadian organization to Go-LIVE with MEDITECH Expanse Ambulatory.

Due to the complexities involved with being the first early adopter of Expanse Ambulatory, Holland Bloorview chose to partner with the most experienced READY-certified consulting firm, Navin Haffty.

With Expanse came the requirement for Holland Bloorview to replace certain third-party vendors, such as the formulary service vendor, with further requirements to adapt products to Canadian workflows and modify dosing to the pediatric environment. These were critical success factors requiring additional Navin Haffty project management support for integration with MEDITECH Expanse and other in-flight systems related to the pharmacy.



Utilizing our vast experience implementing Expanse, Navin Haffty leveraged efficiencies throughout the project. Enhancement of the MEDITECH READY program was facilitated through use of our project management methodology and tools, specifically designed around the READY implementation approach. Expanse went LIVE on time, and now plays a key role in supporting Holland Bloorview's digital health strategy, while providing improved efficiencies and clinician satisfaction. The new EHR also benefits ErinoakKids Centre for Treatment and Development, the largest children's treatment centre in Ontario, for which Holland Bloorview provides EHR hosting. With Navin Haffty's assistance, ErinoakKids went LIVE on the new platform three months after Holland Bloorview. For both organizations, the integration of patient data across the continuum of care is delivering significant improvements to the quality and efficiency of patient care.
